The BC Council of Forest Industries is pleased to announce that it is now accepting applications for the 2022 Forestry Scholarship.

Part of COFI's mission is to support students pursuing post-secondary education or training in a skilled trades program associated with the forest industry. COFI is awarding 13 \$2,000 scholarships this year including three Indigenous focused forestry scholarships through our partnership with New Relationship Trust Foundation.

Eligibility

- Enrolled in a British Columbia accredited post-secondary institution in the fall of 2022 or 2nd semester 2023
- Resident of British Columbia
- Entering a forestry-related program (see next page for a list of acceptable fields of study)

Application Requirements

- Provide a copy of your most recent high school transcript
- Provide a one-page statement outlining your educational goals, why forestry is important to you and plans for the future.
- Provide two letters of reference from either a principal, teacher, community member, or an employer.

Eligible Institutions

The Forestry Scholarship is awarded to students planning to attend an accredited post-secondary institution in a program listed under 'Fields of Study'.
