Introduction

The BC Council of Forest Industries is proud to announce that it is now accepting applications for the 2024 Forestry Scholarship.

Part of COFI's mission is to support students pursuing post-secondary education or training in a skilled trades program associated with the forest industry. COFI is awarding 13 scholarships of \$2,000 this year which includes three Indigenous focused forestry scholarships through a partnership with New Relationship Trust Foundation.



The NRT Foundation assists indigenous students to achieve their educational goals. Scholarships and Bursaries are available

to students pursuing a post-secondary education from a recognized institution. Indigenous students are encouraged to apply for the COFI-NRTF awards through the NRT Foundation at nrtf.ca



Eligibility

- Enrolled in a British Columbia accredited post-secondary institution in the fall of 2024 or spring 2025.
- Resident of British Columbia.
- Entering a forestry-related program (see next page for a list of acceptable fields of study).

Application Requirements

- Provide a copy of your most recent high school transcript.
- Provide a one-page statement outlining your educational goals and plans for your future.
- Provide two letters of reference from either a principal, teacher, community member, or an employer.
